1.1. Express Paragraph 6.¹ as follows:

“6.¹ In the annual working timetable, train path numbers must correspond to the number range assigned to the relevant transportation market segment (Annex 5). The train path numbers of other train categories that are not indicated in Annex 5 must correspond to the directives provided by the infrastructure manager.”

1.2. Supplement Annex 3:

1.2.1. part “Freight traffic” with a supplementary line:

Jelgava – Glūda – Reņģe – the national border	15., 21.
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1.2.2. part “International passenger traffic” with a supplementary line:

Rīga Pasažieru – Reņģe – the national border (<i>odd and even directions</i>)	14., 15., 21.
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2. The capacity allocation body publishes these amendments on its website on the internet and submits them to the infrastructure manager for inclusion in the railway infrastructure network statement.

3. These amendments enter into force upon their publication.
